



Parent Code of Conduct

We, the P.A.C League have implemented the following Parent Code of Conduct for the important message it holds about the proper role of parents in supporting their child in sports. Parents should read, understand and sign this form prior to their children participating in our league. Any parent or guest guilty of improper conduct at any game or practice will be asked to leave the park. Repeat violations may cause a multiple game suspension, or the season forfeiture of the privilege of attending all games.

1. I understand that children participate to have fun and learn. I agree to make learning the game of baseball a priority over winning.
2. I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a game or his/her performance.
3. I will praise my child for competing fairly and trying hard, and make my child feel like a winner every time.
4. I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.
5. I agree to learn the rules of the game and the policies of the P.A.C. League. Should I have any questions or concerns with the League's rules or policies I will schedule a time to meet with the League Administration to discuss my concerns.
6. I understand that the game is for children, not adults.
7. I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.
8. I understand that good sportsmanship is an integral part of the P.A.C League. I agree to teach my child to play by the rules and to treat other players, coaches, umpires, and spectators with respect and courtesy regardless of the outcome of the game. In addition I, my child and my guests will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct such as booing and taunting, refusing to shake hands or using profane language or gestures.
9. I will respect the officials and their authority during games and will never question, discuss, or confront coaches or umpires at the game field and will take time to speak with coaches at an agreed upon place and time.
10. I understand that it is my responsibility to ensure that my child is present and on time to all games and practices. I agree to inform the coach if we are running late or will be unable to attend a game or practice.
11. I understand that the P.A.C. League is a volunteer organization for the benefit of my child and that at times I may be called upon to assist in League functions. I agree to make myself available throughout the season to assist the League whenever my services may be needed.
